Benton-C Bainbridge is an artist, designer and educator based in The Bronx. Bainbridge makes movies, installations, and live visual performances with custom digital, analog and optical systems of his own design. Inspired as a teen by Expanded Cinema and American experimental film and video artists, Benton-C has presented video as immersive environments and extemporaneous compositions across 5 continents, collaborating with scores of artists around the world.

Currently, Benton-C Bainbridge is exhibiting video paintings and installations, and continuing work on the expanded documentary "Brother Islands". With Glowing Pictures, Bainbridge and V Owen Bush are producing documentaries and video meditations for the fortieth anniversary edition of "Be Here Now" by Ram Dass.
